Emergency Plan: **Crenshaw Field**
445 Westhampton Way Richmond, VA 23173

Emergency Personnel: certified athletic trainer and/or Safety Officers on site for practice and competition

Emergency Communication: Cellular phone of athletic trainer/coach/Safety Officer and/or blue light emergency phone located next to Keller Hall. A phone is also located inside Modlin Center.

Emergency Equipment: Sport Club First Aid kit

- AED located inside Modlin Center
- Additional emergency equipment accessible from Weinstein Center Sport Club Athletic Training Room.

Roles of Safety Officers/First Responders

1. Immediate care of the injured or ill student-athlete
2. Activation of emergency medical system (EMS)
 - Call University Police at 289-9111 (8911 from fixed telephone line): provide name, location of field, telephone number; number of individuals injured; condition of injured; first aid treatment; specific directions; other information as requested.
3. Emergency equipment retrieval: AED is located in Modlin Center (1st floor inside main entrance; outside Frederick Rehearsal Hall); Sport Club First Aid Kit; additional emergency equipment accessible from Weinstein Center Sport Club Athletic Training Room.
4. Direction of EMS to scene
 - Designate individual to "flag down" EMS and direct to scene
 - Scene control: limit scene to first aid providers and move bystanders away from area.

Venue Directions: 445 Westhampton Way Richmond, VA 23173: From College Road. Turn onto Westhampton Way (Westhampton Entrance) and the next right onto Westhampton Way (formally Crenshaw Way). Take 3rd left into parking lot and Crenshaw Field will be straight ahead.

Position where personal will meet emergency help:

- One person will be on Crenshaw Way by parking lot entrance to direct ambulance.

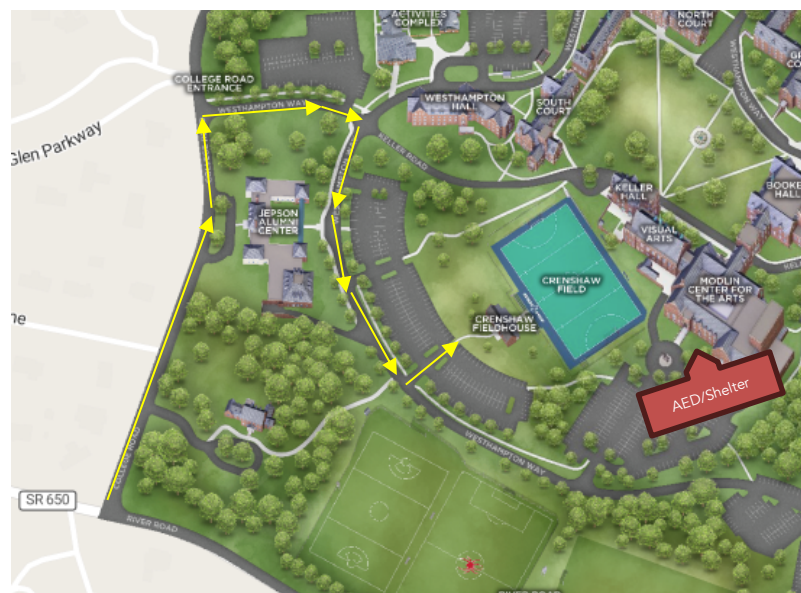

Emergency Equipment: AED is located on East Concourse of Robins Stadium (across from concessions). Secondary location: International Weinstein Center (Passport entrance near elevator). Sport Club First Aid Kit. Additional emergency equipment is accessible from Weinstein Center Sport Club Athletic Training Room and/or IM Shed Sport Club Athletic Training Room.

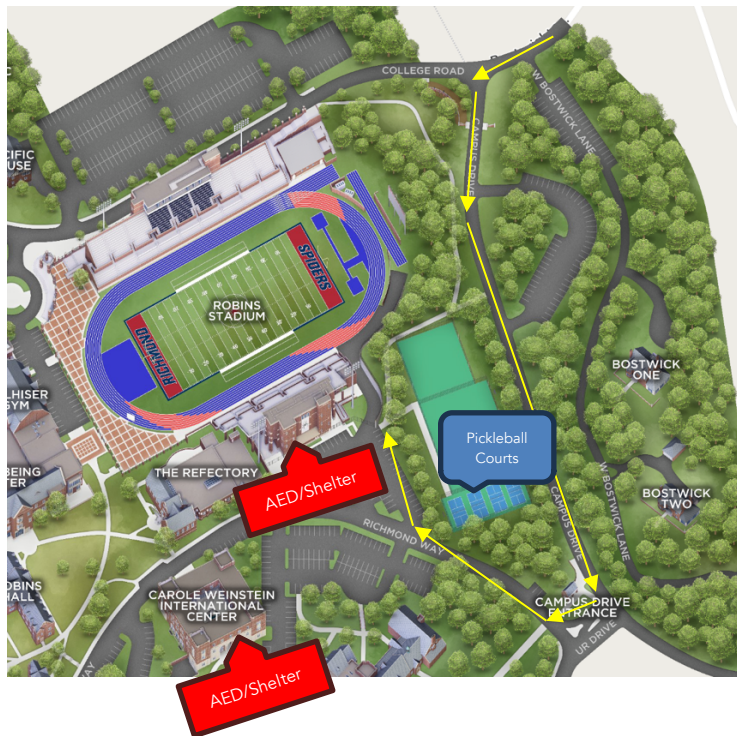

Emergency Equipment: AED is located in Modlin Center (1st floor inside main entrance; outside Frederick Rehearsal Hall); Sport Club First Aid Kit; additional emergency equipment accessible from Weinstein Center Sport Club Athletic Training Room.

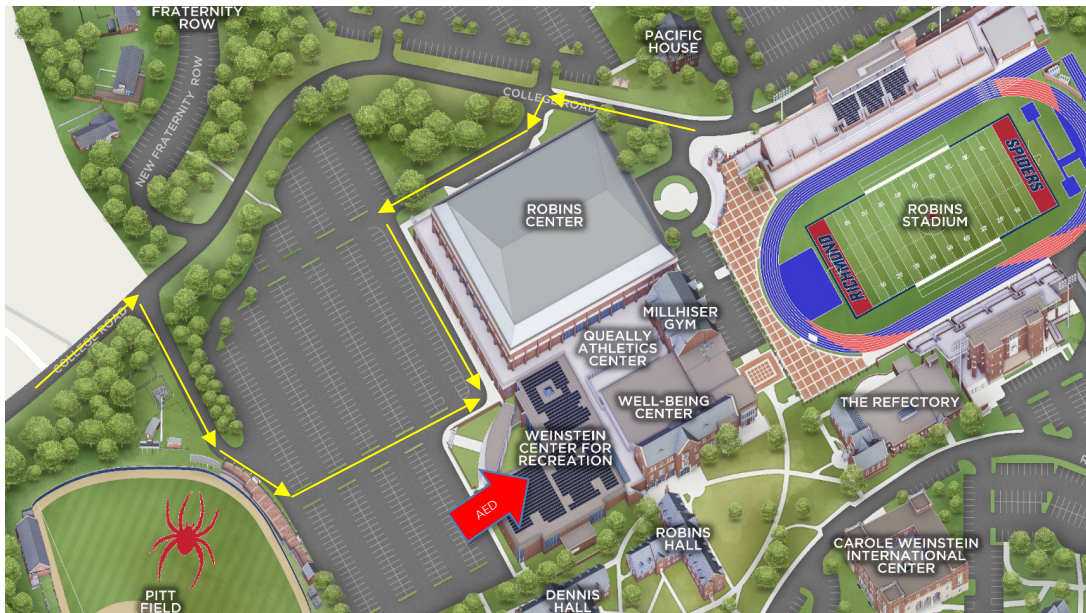
