Weinstein Center for Recreation Update June 23, 2020

The University has released plans for the fall semester that include a return of students to campus. Under the guidance of the University phased plan, the Weinstein Center is making plans to re-open a temporary fitness facility with physical distancing and limited capacity for students, faculty and staff only. Keep in mind, many of the spaces within the Weinstein Center are being used as temporary classroom space in order to comply with physical distancing requirements for students and faculty. We do not have a specific timeframe of when the University will reach a more regular operating plan and resume allowing more visitors to campus. Although we know you are disappointed with the delay in Weinstein Center for Recreation access, the University is doing their best to make decisions that keep the campus community as safe as possible during this difficult time. We value the relationship we have with our paid members and hope to resume your access as soon as it is safe to do so within the University guidelines.

As a reminder, monthly bank drafts will <u>not</u> be processed during the facility closure. Once we determine a reopen date for the Weinstein Center and access to the facility for paid members, we will communicate the date bank drafts will resume, giving members plenty of notice.

Expiration dates for annual memberships will be extended for the number of days equal to the duration of the Weinstein Center COVID-19 closure. The extension will be based on March 17th (the date Weinstein Center closed) through your original expiration date. We are not processing renewals until your access is reinstated.

Member Services is in the process of coordinating a schedule for members to retrieve items from lockers. Details will be sent directly to those who have assigned lockers.
